PROFILE: Frank Bisceglia



After spending most of my life in the Pittsburgh area, I moved to Beaver in 2015. I was immediately impressed by the active Art scene. I was warmly welcomed into several local Art organizations which are the Beaver Valley Artists, Beaver Art Group, and Midland Arts Council. The level of talent and commitment exhibited by members of these groups is truly remarkable, and I feel fortunate to be included.

I received a Bachelor of Science in Art Education from Edinboro University in 1967. Later, I earned a Master's Degree in Instructional Design and Technology, and eventually a Doctorate in Education from the University of Pittsburgh. I have taught Art for more than 40 years at various levels from Preschool to Community College in both urban and rural settings. I retired from the Pittsburgh School District in 2006, and currently teach PAINTING WITH ACRYLICS at CCBC.

A few memorable experiences outside of teaching have included a Fulbright Scholarship to research Traditional Arts in Africa, documenting Prehistoric Petroglyphs in Italy, creating Installations at the Heinze Historical Center, and traveling to Galleries and Museums in more than 30 countries.

My philosophy of Art is simple. First, any activity performed with Mindfulness and Intent can be an Art. Secondly, since our perceptions are defined by personal parameters, let critiques be an opportunity to share in the creative process, rather than only a format for expressing dogmatic beliefs.



I eagerly look forward to continue sharing studio time, snacks, and camaraderie with other like minded artists at B.A.G., BVA, and MAC. Thank you all for helping me remain immersed in a sea of Creativity.

The Carnegie Museum of Art Exhibition, A Delight for the Senses: The Still Life is a celebration of this humble genre, exploring nearly 250 years of the tradition from the 17th century to America's Gilded Age. These sumptuous arrays of objects ranging from the mundane to the luxurious reveal moral undertones and allusions to the transience of life. This exhibition features loans from the Detroit Institute of Arts and several local collectors, along with recent bequests from the late Drue Heinz, including the only Flemish 17th century still life in the museum's collection, on view for the first time.
