Letter from the president

Hello Everyone,

I hope this finds you well. As we move out of the gray winter into a more colorful spring, upcoming BVA activities may give you something to look forward to.

- * In March, we will have a brief meeting followed by a group critique.
- * In April, we will have a short meeting to discuss our upcoming show, and we will drop off our artwork for the show. We won't have a program in April.
- * Our show will open on April 25th. The opening will be more low key than usual. (A show prospectus will be sent out by the end of February.)
- * In May, our juror will provide a critique. We will take utmost precautions for all of these events, including masks and distancing.

With our group critique in mind, it is worthwhile to consider the elements and principles of design. The elements of art are the visual tools that artists use to create a composition. These are line, shape, color, value, form, texture and space. The principles of design are created using the elements of design. They are balance, contrast, emphasis, movement, pattern, rhythm, and unity/variety.

One of the most interesting principles is Rhythm. This excerpt from a blog post of the Principle Gallery explains it:

"Rhythm, in reference to visual artwork, describes the way that the elements flow into one another. There is a movement to the way we experience the image.

Thinking of this concept in musical terms is a fascinating and effective way to grasp the ideas more fully. Imagine that as you look at a painting, the movement of your eye results in audible sounds. Would the sequence of sounds slowly and easily flow into one another, or would they have abrupt changes and vivid contrast? 'Hearing' the 'music' of a painting helps the viewer appreciate more deeply the thoughtful way in which the artist arranged the elements of line, value, etc."

BVA member Rob Ivanisn will have two pieces "ALICE" & "Depression" in the "Trigger Warning" show at The Sweetwater Center.




